123RD TECHNICAL GRADUATE COURSE (TGC-123) (JUL 2016)



1. Applications are invited from married/unmarried MALE Engineering Graduates for Grant of Permanent Commission in the Army in all Arms/Services. 123rd Technical Graduate Course will commence in July 2016 at Indian Military Academy (IMA), Dehradun,

2. ELIGIBILITY:

LIGIBILITY:

(a) Nationality: A candidate must either be: (i) A citizen of India, or (ii) A subject of Bhutan, or (iii) A subject of Nepal, or (iv) a Tibetan refugee who came over to India before the 1st of January 1962 with the intention of permanently settling in India or (v) a person of Indian origin who has migrated from Pakistan, Burma, Sri Lanka and East African countries of Kenya, Uganda, the United Republic of Tanzania, Zambia, Malawi, Zaire and Ethopia and Vietnam with the intention of permanently settling in India. Provided that a candidate belonging to categories (ii), (iii), (iv) and (v) above shall be a person in whose favour a certificate of eligibility has been issued by Government of India. Certificate of eligibility has been issued by Government of the necessary in the case of candidates. India. Certificate of eligibility will however not be necessary in the case of candidates who are Gorkha subjects of Nepal.

(b) Age Limit: – 20 to 27 years as on 01 Jul 2016. (Candidates born between 02 Jul 89 and 01 Jul 96, both dates inclusive).

NOTE: The date of birth entered in the Matriculation or an equivalent examination certificate only is accepted by this office. No other document relating to age will be accepted and no subsequent request for its change will be considered or granted.

(c) $\underline{\text{Educational Qualification}}$: Candidates should have passed Engineering Degree or be in the final year of Engineering Degree course. The candidates in the final year of Degree Course should complete all their examinations related to the degree, prior to 01 July 2016. They should be able to produce the Engineering Degree within 12 weeks from the date of commencement of training at IMA. Such candidates will be inducted on Additional Bond Basis for recovery of the cost of training at IMA as notified from time to time as well as stipend and pay & allowances paid, in case they fail to produce the requisite Degree Certificate.

Important Note:- Candidates must note that the minimum educational qualification for induction into TGC-123 is BE/B.Tech degree in the Engineering streams notified below. Therefore, to become eligible for induction into TGC-123 course, candidates studying in final year of engineering must complete all the formalities including written, practicals, projects, backlogs, viva voce, etc for award of qualifying BE/B.Tech degree before commencement of course (01 Jul 2016) failing which their candidature is liable to be cancelled.

NOTE: These vacancies are tentative and may be changed depending on availability of ng slots. No equivalence of Engineering stream will be accepted.

4. TYPE OF COMMISSION:

- (a) <u>Grant of Commission</u>: Selected candidates will be granted Short Service Commission on probation in the rank of Lt from the date of commencement of the course or the date of reporting at IMA, whichever is later and will be entitled to full pay and allowances admissible to Lt during training period. Pay & allowances will be paid after successful completion of training.
- (b) <u>Permanent Commission</u>: On successful completion of training cadets will be granted Permanent Commission in the Army in the rank of Lt.

 (c) <u>Ante Date Seniority</u>: One year ante date seniority from the date of commission will be granted to Engineering Graduates of TGC Entry.
- 5. TRAINING: Duration of training is one year.
 - (a) Selected candidates will be detailed for training at Indian Military Academy, Dehradun according to their position in the final order of merit up to the number of vacancies available in each stream.
 - (b) Candidates are neither be allowed to marry during the period of training nor he be allowed to live with parents/Guardians. A candidate who marries during training shall be discharged and will be liable to refund all expenditure incurred on him by the government. A candidate, who marries subsequent to the date of his application, though successful, will not be selected for training.
 - (c) <u>Cost of Training</u>: The entire cost of training is at Government expense. In case the GC is withdrawn from training academy due to reasons other than Medical ground or the reasons not beyond his control, he will be liable to refund cost of training @ Rs.
 - 8785/ -per week for the period of his stay at Indian Military Academy.

 (d) <u>Army Group Insurance Fund</u>. The Gentlemen Cadets of IMA in receipt of stipend are insured for Rs. 60 lac.
- The Final allocation of Arms/Services will be made prior to passing out of gentleman adets from IMA. Officers may be granted commission in any Arms/Services and will be iable for service in any part of the country/world on selected appointments as decided by Army Headquarters from time to time.
- 7. PAY AND ALLOWANCES: The candidates will be given a stipend of Rs. 21,000/- p.m. (Rs 15,600/- as pay in Pay Band plus Grade Pay of Rs. 5,400/-). On completion of training they will be commissioned in the rank of Lt and entitled to pay as admissible to the rank. Army also provides free medical facilities for self & dependents, canteen facilities, entitled ration, Mess/Club/Sports facilities, furnished govt.accommodation, car/housing loan at subsidized rate. 8. HOW TO APPLY:

(a) Applications will only be accepted online on website "www.joinindianarmy.nic.in". Click on Officer Menu then go to How to Apply and then click ONLINE APPLICATION. Fill the online registration form. Note down the userid and password. Tips to assist in filling up fields have been provided as you click on ONLINE APPLICATION. Before submitting the application check the entries made

(b) Documents to be carried to the Selection Centre by the candidate:-

- One copy of the Print out of application duly signed and affixed with photograph self attested by the candidate.

 (ii) Self attested copy of Matriculation or equivalent certificate for age proof.

 (iii) Self attested copy of 12th Class Certificate & Marksheet.

 (iv) Self attested copy of Engineering Degree/Provisional Degree

 (v) Self attested copy of Mark sheets of all Semesters

 (vi) Certificate from the Principal/Head of the Institution stating that the candidate is in

- final year and all exams will be over by 01 July 2016, for final year candidates.

 (vii) All certificates in original. Originals will be returned after verification at the Service Selection Board itself.

- (e) Candidates must submit only one application. Receipt of multiple applications from the same candidate will result in cancellation of candidature.

ONLINE APPLICATION WILL OPEN ON 28 SEP 2015 AT 1000 HRS AND WILL BE CLOSED ON 27 OCT 2015 AT 1700 HRS.

9. SELECTION PROCEDURE: The selection procedure is as follows:-

- (a) Short listing of Applications. Integrated HQ of MoD(Army) reserves the right to shortlist applications and to fix cutoff percentage of marks for each Engineering discipline/
- stream without assigning any reason.

 (b) Only shortlisted eligible candidates depending on the cutoff percentage will be interviewed at Selection Centres, Allahabad (UP), Bhopal (MP) and Bangalore (Karnataka) by Psychologist, Group Testing Officer and Interviewing Officer. Call Up letter for SSB interview will be issued by the respective Selection Centres, through candidate's registered e-mail id and through SMS. Candidates will not be interviewed locally. Allotment of Selection Centre is at the discretion of DG Rtg, IHQ MoD (Army) and no request for changes are entertained in this regard.

 (c) SSB Interviews will be held from Jan 2016 onwards.
- (d) Candidates will put through two stage selection procedure. Those who clear Stage I will go to Stage II. Those who fail in Stage I will be returned on the same date. Duration of SSB interviews is five days excluding day of arrival and details of the same are available at official website of Rtg Dte www.joinindianarmy.nic.in

10. PHYSICAL STANDARD

- (a) Candidates must be physically fit according to the prescribed physical standards. The guidelines for the same are available at official website of Dte Gen Recruiting

- 11. MEDICAL EXAMINATION: A candidate recommended by the Services Selection Board will undergo a medical examination by a Board of Service Medical officers. Only those candidates will be admitted to the academy who are declared fit by the Medical board. The details for the same are available at official website of Directorate General Recruiting www.joinindianarmy.nic.in
- 12. MERIT LIST: IT IS TO BE NOTED THAT MERE QUALIFYING AT THE SSB INTERVIEW DOES NOT CONFIRM FINAL SELECTION. MERIT LIST WILL BE PREPARED ENGINEERING STREAM/SUBJECT WISE ON THE BASIS OF THE MARKS OBTAINED BY THE CANDIDATE AT SSB INTERVIEW. HIGHER EDUCATIONAL QUALIFICATIONS, PREVIOUS PERFORMANCES, NCC BACKGROUND, ETC HAVE NO ROLE TO PLAY. THOSE IN THE MERIT LIST AND WHO COME WITHIN THE STIPULATED STREAM WISE VACANCIES, AND ARE MEDICALLY FIT ARE ISSUED JOINING LETTERS FOR PRE-COMMISSIONING TRAINING AT IMA.
 - (a) The merit list of the recommended candidates will be displayed at the reception of DG
 - Recruiting and its website i.e.www.joinindianarmy.nic.in by 1st week of Jun 2016.

 (b) Recommended candidates of TGC who do not come within the number of vacancy, may be offered SSC(T), subject to availability of vacancy, and after allotment of all eligible SSC(T) candidates.
- 13. CHANGE OF INTERVIEW DATES: Request for change of SSB Interview date should be avoided. However, under most unavoidable circumstances, such change may be considered based on the circumstances of the case. This will be an exception rather than the rule. Request for such change should be forwarded to Selection Centre from where the call-up letter for SSB interview has been received and not to Directorate General Recruiting.
- 14. ENTITLEMENT FOR TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE: Candidates appearing for SSB interview for the first time for a particular type of commission shall be entitled for AC-III Tier to and fro Railway fare or Bus fare including reservation cum sleeper charges within the Indian limit. Candidates who apply again for the same type of commission will not be entitled to travelling allowance on any subsequent occasion.
- 15. On joining the Army, some of personal restrictions in service will be imposed in accordance with Article 33 of the Constitution of India as promulgated in the Army Act and Army Rules from time to time.
- NOTE 1: Any ambiguity / false information/ concealment of information detected in the certificates will result in cancellation of the candidature at any stage of selection
